

GUIDELINES FOR SOCIAL WORK ETHICS CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) CONTENT

Each course approved for CE in Social Work Ethics should show evidence clear goals, objectives, content, and activities related to a minimum of two (2) of the following criteria:

1. The history and evolution of ethics in social work.
2. Ethics decision making models and/or theories
3. Professional Standards of social work practice (discuss inclusion of reference, i.e. ASWB, NABSW, IFSW)
4. State legal requirements for ethical social work conduct
5. Ethical decision making processes and dilemmas
6. Professional social work values and self-awareness
7. The major sections of the Standards of Professional Conduct and Ethics as described in the Alabama State Board of Social Work Examiners Administrative Code, Chapter 850-X-9
 - a. The Social Worker's Conduct and Comportment as a Social Worker
 - b. The Social Worker's Ethical Responsibility to Clients
 - c. The Social Worker's Ethical Responsibility to Colleagues
 - d. The Social Worker's Ethical Responsibility to the Employer
 - e. The Social Worker's Ethical Responsibility to the Profession
 - f. The Social Worker's Ethical Responsibility to Society
