

**The Alabama State Board of Social Work Examiners  
Board Meeting Minutes  
March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Alabama State Board of Social Work Examiners was held on March 2, 2022, 2022 at the Montgomery office. Board Chair, Kai Mumpfield, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Unless otherwise specified, all votes were taken by verbal yes or no. Proper notice for the meeting was provided to the Secretary of State and posted on the Secretary of State website.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

Minutes from the January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, were distributed with the corrected changes. Dr. Sherrod made a motion to approve the minutes and Kai Mumpfield seconded the motion, and all voted to pass the minutes.

#### **Old Board Business**

a. Jamie DeLee made a motion to accept approval of new licenses issued since the last Board meeting. Wendy Peek seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. We had a total of 86 new licenses.

b. Update on Complaint status we currently have (4) open complaints, and we are waiting on social workers responses and then they will be distributed to board members for review.

#### **New Board Business**

a. Rachel Dickinson presented the financial report. We have a new data base coming this month and website updates along with an application that will allow licensees to use their phone to submit more information to the Board.

b. power point for trainings was discussed and it is time for a newsletter to be sent out.

c. Supervisor Training Program Review:

- JSU proposal – motion to approve with additional information requested by the board:
  1. include an evaluation tool in the proposal.
  2. more agenda detail.
  3. include a previous training history; and finally,

4. If this training is virtual it must be live, not prerecorded

Motion was made by Dr. Sherrod and seconded by Kai Mumpfield, motion carried with a yes vote by all.

- Auburn proposal - motion to approve with additional information requested by the board:

1. include an evaluation tool that can be submitted after the training.

2. include a history of training and previous trainings.

3. amend the original proposal to include the above and the information submitted last week.

A motion was made by Jamie DeLee and seconded by Ukawia Johnson, motion carried with a yes vote by all.

- NASW proposal- Discussed by the board and it was determined that ALL applicants are considered at baseline to be a supervisor regardless how long they have been supervising. The Director was asked to ask NASW to respond to additional information and resubmit to the Board at the next meeting.

d. Clinical Legislation has been drafted and we Senator Roger Smitherman or Senator Bobby Singleton will be asked to drop the bill next week.

### **Other Requests**

State of Social Work address to be held potentially in June. The board will meet to address access for questions and answers, current changes and, the importance of being licensed. Groups to be invited are any groups or organizations that work with different roles in social work. CEU's will be offered for free. June 14<sup>th</sup> 8am-12 is the proposed date.

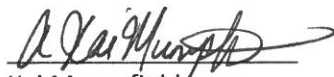

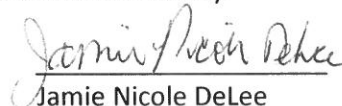
