

The Board currently has three Member positions open for appointments. The positions are for **US Congressional Districts 3, 4 and 7** (please see the map below). The positions open are for a Licensed Bachelor Social Worker, Licensed Master Social Worker and a Licensed Independent Clinical Social Worker who are current and in good standing to serve a term which will end September 30, 2029. If you are a licensed social worker at any of these levels of licensure, from these Districts, and are interested in serving on the Board, you may start collecting letters of nomination from fellow social workers from your District.

The nomination letters and a resume must be mailed to the Board at 100 North Union Street, Suite 736, Montgomery, Alabama 36104, postmarked by October 1, 2026. If this is not something you're interested in but wish to submit a letter on behalf of someone, please submit to the address above. We will accept nomination letters through October 1, 2026. We then submit the top three names who receive the most nominations for that District to the Governor's Appointment Office. The Governor's Office then makes the final selection from the list of persons submitted.

There is no pay for serving under this capacity, but you are reimbursed for in state and out-of-state travel expenses at the same rate as a state employee.

The duties of the Board are:

- To protect the public from incompetent, unethical and unlawful social work practice.
 - To enforce qualification standards for all levels of licensure and certification.
 - To delineate unlawful conduct through disciplinary procedures against practitioners who violate applicable laws or rules.
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Nomination Requirements:

- The person being nominated and the person doing the nominating **must** both live in the same District.
- You can nominate yourself.
- The person making the nomination must be a licensed social worker.
- Nomination letters must be mailed, or hand delivered, you may collect the letters and send them in all together.
